Then suddenly I thought of Bobby Decker.

I knew that Bobby Decker didn’t have a coat, because he never went outside to play in the winter.

⑯That was it! I would buy Bobby Decker a coat. I found a dark blue ⑰one with a hood. I knew ⑱it was really warm. That’s because I tried it on. ⑲Bobby was about the same size as me.

“Is this a present for someone?” the lady behind the counter asked when I ⑳ my bill on the counter. “Yes, it is,” I said, looking up at her. “It’s for Bobby. He is my classmate.”

The lady put the coat into a bag. ㉑I didn’t get any change, but she smiled at me and said, “Merry Christmas.”

That night Grandma came over and helped me wrap the coat. A little tag ㉒(fall) out of the coat, and Grandma put it in between the pages of her *Bible. I ㉓(choose) the paper and the ribbons and wrote “To Bobby, From Santa” on the outside.

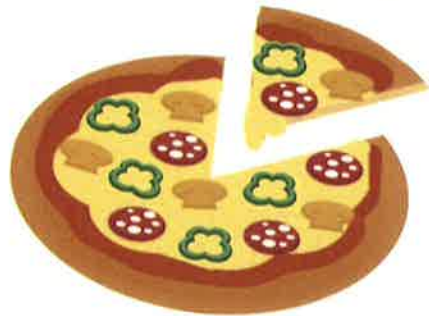
